4. Competition Regulations

The Malta International Open 2020 will be Silver Qualification Event for Tokyo 2020. The Competition will be held accordance to the IWFTechnical and Competition Rules and Regulations.

5. Eligibility

Olympic Qualification Event

The minimum age for participating lifters is for those born in **2005**. There is no maximum age limed to compete

In accordance with Article 5.6.5 of the IWF Anti-Doping Policy an athlete who is not listed on the IWF's Registered Testing Pool but wishes to participate in an IWF event shall provide accurate and complete whereabouts information as set out at Annex I of the International Standard for Testing and Investigationsfora period of at least two monthsprior to the IWF event inquestion. A lifter who does not comply with this provision is not eligible to compete at the IWF event.

Lifters who wish to compete in the Malta International Open 2020 shall submit their whereabouts information for the period outlined above at the latest on <u>29th December 2019</u>

6. Body Weight Categories

The Malta International Open will compete in the IWF Senior bodyweight categories:

Women	45kg	49kg	55kg	59kg	64kg	71kg	76kg	81kg	87kg	+87kg

7. Number of invited athletes per each Country

The number of athletes that Member Federation can enter into each bodyweight category is two, but the maximum team size must not exceed 10 + 2r lifters men and 10 + 2r lifters women.

Due to the limit on the number of places available at the competition all places will be issued on a firstcome, first-served basis determined by the payment of the appropriate entry fee.

8. Number of invited Technical Officials

Participating Federations can nominate Category 1 or 2 ITO and hold a valid IWF Licence. Selected Technical officials will be communicated by 17th January 2020.

16. Flags and National Anthem

Each National Federation is kindly requested to bring 2 (two) National Flags 110cm x 150cm)







17. <u>Awards</u>

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the three highest ranked lifters in Snatch, Clean & Jerk and Total for each IWF Senior bodyweight category.

National anthems will be played during the Total medal ceremonies for each category. Diplomas and Gifts will be given to each participant.

18. Doping Control

Doping Control will be conducted in accordance with the IWF Anti-Doping Policy.

19. Sport Equipment

The Malta International Open 2020 will use IWF approved Olympic weightlifting equipment.

20. Insurance

All Member Federations must provide travel and Accident insurance for all their participants before leaving their countries on accordance with the IWF Regulations.

- a. The average temperature in Malta during the championships is 17 degrees Celsius.
- b. The currency used on the Maltese islands is the Euro.
- c. The three-pin rectangular plug system is used (220-240 V)
- d.
