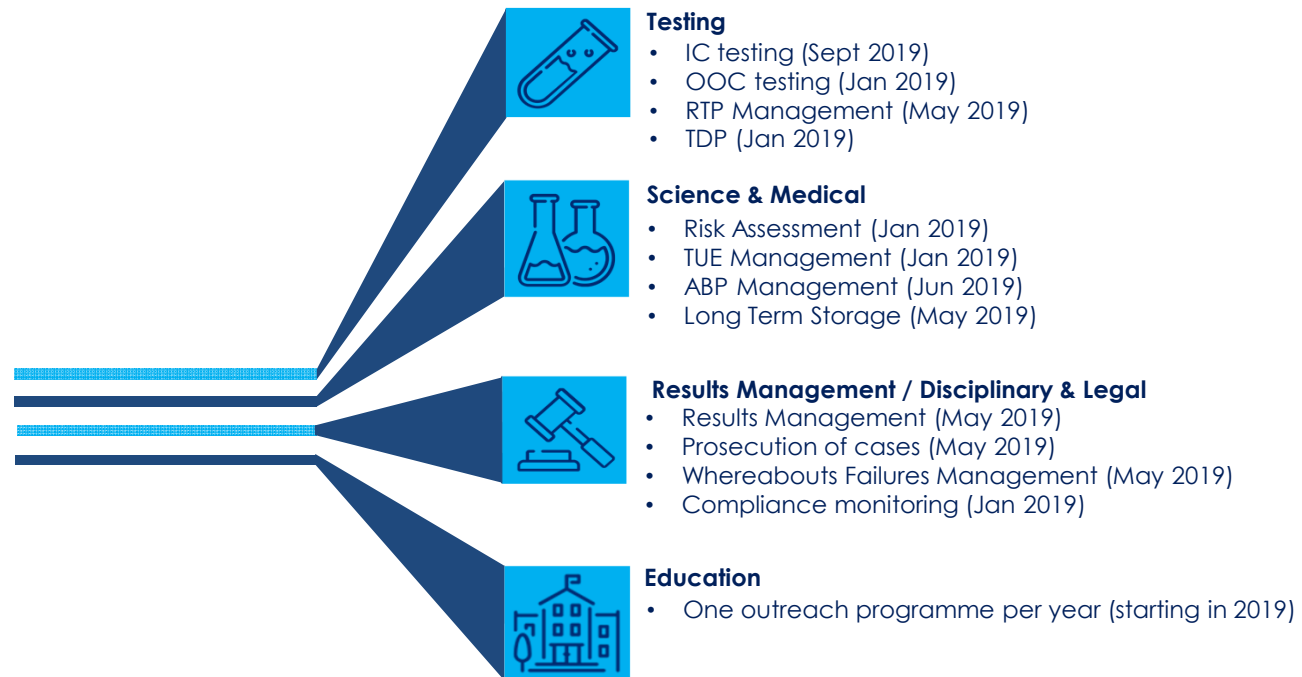

How does this impact the IWF Anti-Doping Programme?

- Delegation of the operational decision-making to an independent entity
- Leverage the anti-doping expertise within the ITA
- Harmonizing testing to ensure equal treatment of weightlifters across countries
- Improved testing effectiveness and intelligence driven doping controls
- Promote clean IWF events and a `clean sport` culture in weightlifting

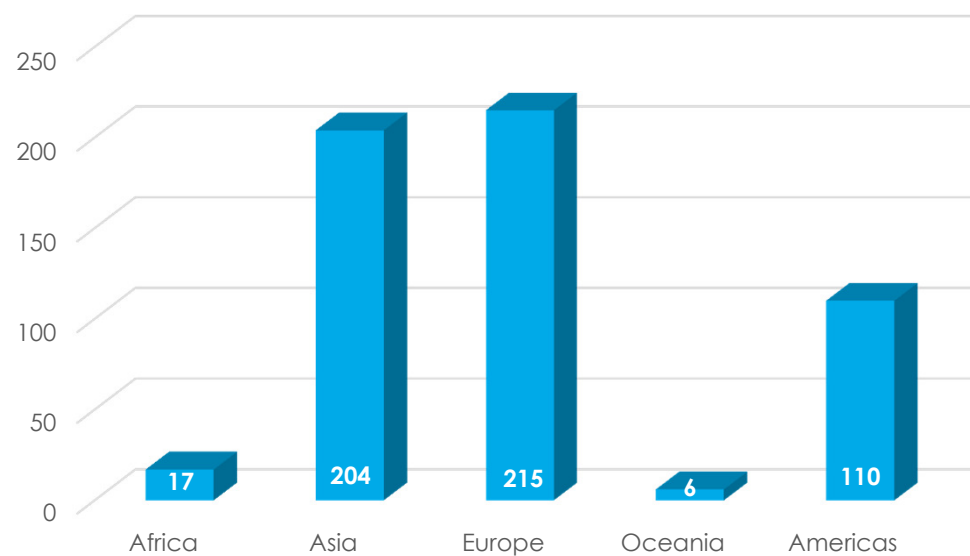

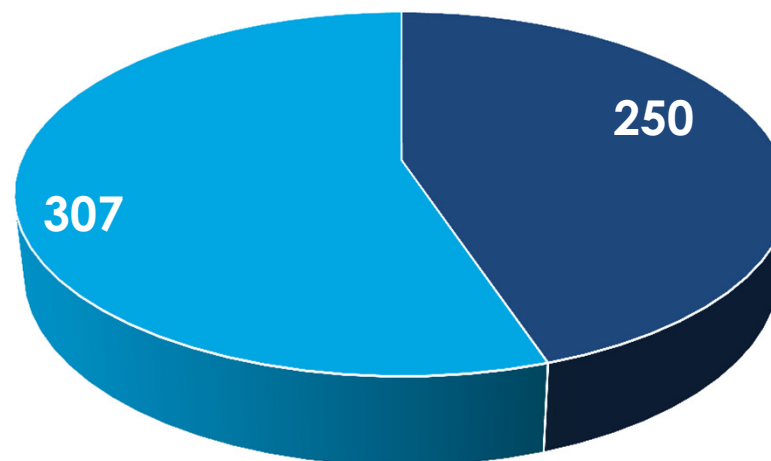

- spread of tests per gender

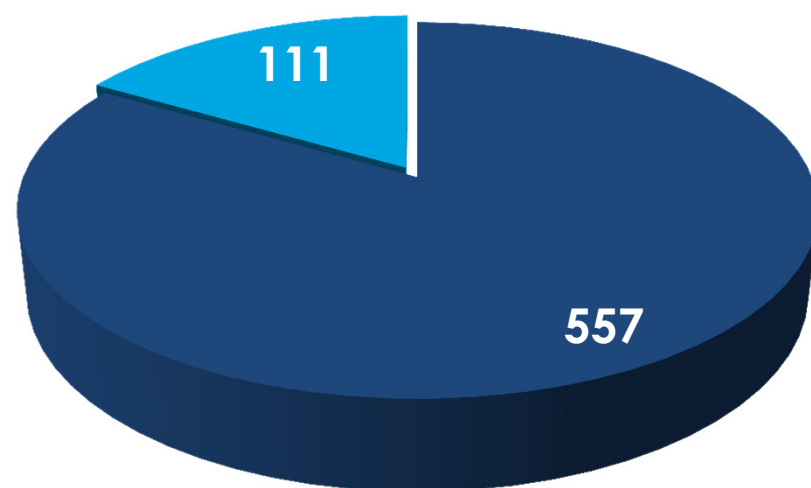

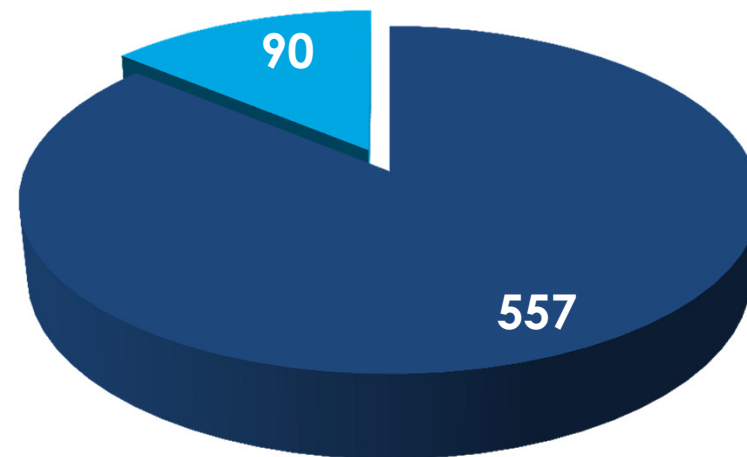
- Urine / Blood

Results Management



- Since May 2019, the ITA has been handling **54 cases** under the Results Management authority of the IWF
- Breakdown of disciplinary proceedings:

No. of cases	21	8	17	8

- The proceedings are at different stages and IWF is regularly kept informed of the advancement of each case

WADA compliance



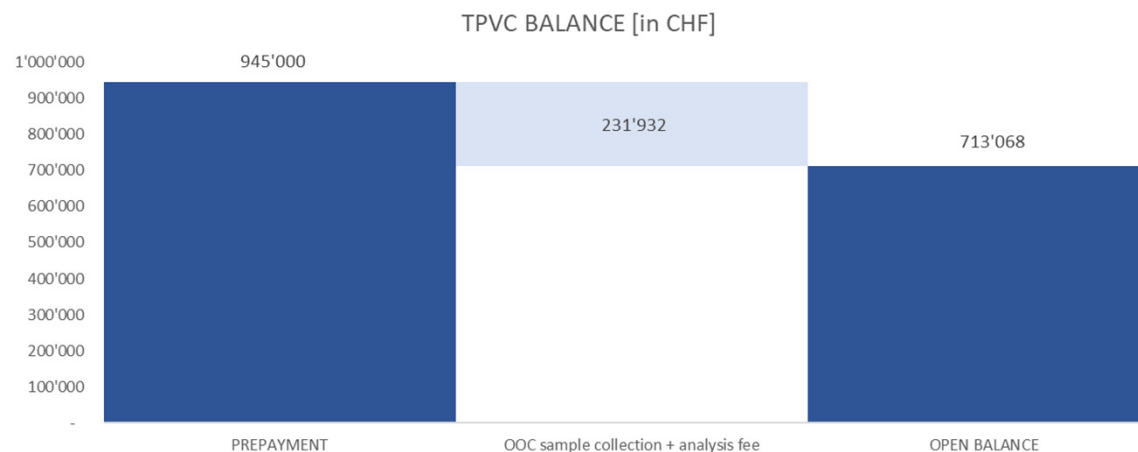
- ITA supported IWF in the recent WADA audit and compliance related process

The chart below summarizes the total amount received as TPVC prepayment (Prepayment) minus all incurred costs which shows the amount left in your favor (Open Balance).

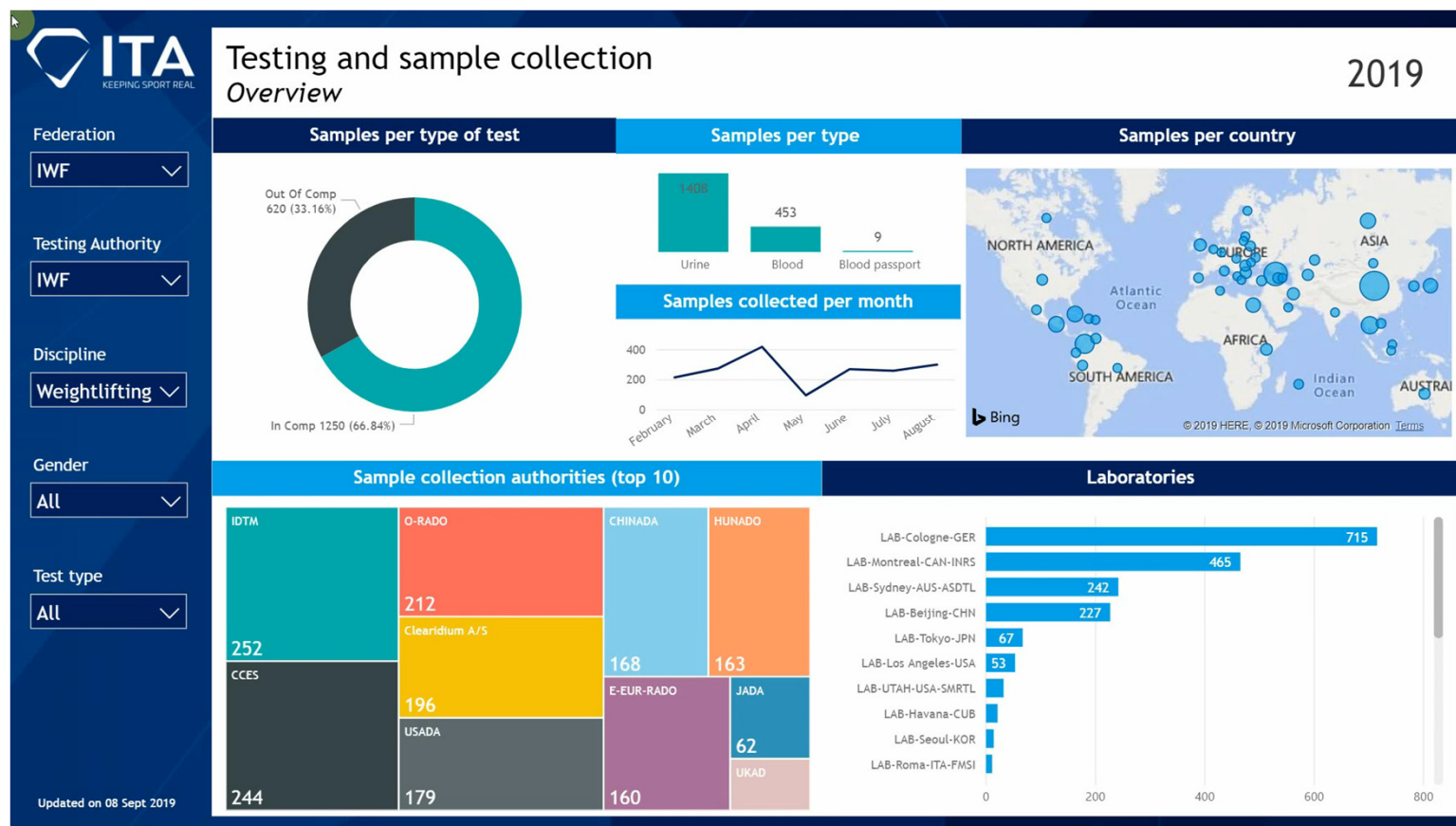
