Re: 2021 African Senior Men & Women Gold Olympic Weightlifting Qualification Championships, May 24-31, 2021 Nairobi, Kenya.

Kenya Amateur Weightlifting Association is very much pleased to invite your National weightlifting team to participate in 2021 African Gold Olympic Weightlifting Qualification Championships for Tokyo 2020 Olympics from May 24, through May 31, 2021 at Nairobi.

#### 1. COMPETITION DATE AND PLACE:

The competition will be held in Nairobi, Kenya from 24<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2021 as Gold Level Qualifying Sports Event for Tokyo Olympic Games.

### 2. TERMS AND CONDITION OF PARTICIPATION:

- A. The competition will be held and organised in accordance to the IWF Technical and Competition Rules & Regulations.
- B. The WFA will appoint the Technical Officials (ITOs) whom will be nominated by their national federations/associations to officiate for the championships.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY:

- A. According to the IWF Technical and Competition Rules & Regulations, the athletes born in 2006 or earlier have the eligibility to participate.
- B. In accordance with article 5.5.16 of the IWF Anti-Doping Policy 2021 <u>and as the championship is relocated to be held in Kenya and was scheduled to be held in Madagascar and start on 19/05/2021, the whereabouts information of the athletes already submitted to ADAMS two months prior to the event (by 19<sup>th</sup> March, 2021).</u>
- C. Only competitors of affiliated national federations/associations that has no arrears towards the IWF & WFA are eligible to participate in this competition.
- D. The passport is considered as the sole official document to proof the age and the eligibility of the athlete.







E. A maximum of ten (10) men and ten (10) women competitors can be registered plus two (2) reserves for each gender may also be entered but during the Verification of Final Entries each country can only register (10) men and (10) women as a final entry without any reserves. And it is possible to change the bodyweight categories and the entry total latest on the Verification of Final Entries.

## 4. COMPETITION EVENTS AND CATEGORIES:

IWF categories for men and women are follows:

Men: 55 kg/61 kg/67 kg/73 kg/81 kg/89 kg/96 kg/102 kg/109 kg/+109 kg Women: 45 kg/49 kg/55 kg/59 kg/64 kg/71 kg/76 kg/81 kg/87 kg/+87 kg

# 5. ENTRY FORMS:

Enclosed herewith please find Final Entry, Accommodation and Transportation Forms.

- A. Preliminary Entry Forms already submitted on 31st March, 2021.
- B. Final Entry Forms, Accommodation and Transportation Forms must be submitted to both the Organizing Committee (KEN WF) and the Weightlifting Federation of Africa (WFA) respectively no later than 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2021.
- Maximum athletes allowed on the Final Entry Form are twelve (12) women and twelve (12) men; this consists of a full team ten (10) women and ten (10) men plus two (2) reserve athletes per gender. Reserve athletes must be noted as such on the Final Entry Form.
- Member federations/associations must select the final list of athletes from the Preliminary Entry (previously submitted by 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2021).
- Please also send together passport size photograph and passport copy of participants.

#### 6. ACCREDITATION:

A. The Organizing Committee will prepare accreditation cards before the arrival of each team, in order to avoid undesired queues at the hotel; it is required from the federations/associations to send the name list and colored e-photos for all the delegates (athletes and officials) to OC by e-mail latest 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 with the final entry forms.







- B. Accreditation of the delegations will take place at <u>Golden Tulip Hotel</u> upon arrival.
- C. Please note that the accreditation will be valid only for the days registered on the accreditation card at the accreditation centre and will be issued only after full payment of participation and entry fees.

#### 7. DOPING CONTROL:

Doping Controls will be carried out by ITA on behalf of IWF by an appointed sample collection authority in accordance with IWF Anti-Doping Policy.

#### 8. ACCOMMODATIONS:

The accommodation for all delegations will be at:

- B. The hotel will be provided from 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 to the end of the competition with the following normal rates:
  - US \$ 120 full board per person per night for standard double rooms.
  - US \$ 130 full board per person per night for standard single rooms.

#### 9. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS:

- A. An Entry Fee of US\$ 150 per athlete (including US \$ 50 Special Anti-Doping Fee) shall be paid to the WFA by each delegation.
- B. Other participants US \$100 per person (except the officials whom will be appointed to officiate during the competition).
- C. A covid-19 test must be taken before travel and a negative PCR test certificate uploaded in trusted travel system global haven up loader before boarding the plane to Kenya.
- D. Travellers are also required to submit a Travellers Health Surveillance form online through the "jitenge" platform prior to get off the plane.
- E. All payments must be made in cash to the Organization Committee preferably in US Dollars upon arrival at the accreditation center.
- F. The WFA is responsible for the Trophies, Medals and Certificates.







- G. The Organizing Committee will cover the accommodation and board costs for three nights for the WFA EB Members.
- H. The Organizing Committee will cover the accommodation and board costs for the technical officials whom will be appointed to officiate for the competition.
- I. The Organizing Committee will cover the accommodation and board costs for the WFA Secretariat Members, IWF representatives. WFA TIS staff and selected Doping Control Officers.

#### 10. AWARDS:

- A. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in each bodyweight category for both men and women in Snatch, Clean & Jerk and Total.
- B. Trophies will be awarded to the best three teams in total respectively for both men's and women's competitions in accordance with IWF Team Classification.
- C. Best lifters trophies will be awarded in both men's and women's events.
- D. Certificates of participation will be presented to all participants.

### 11. COMPETITION AND TRAINING VENUES:

Competition and training venues will be at Ruaraka Sports Club 10 minutes drive from the Hotel.

#### 12. SPORT EQUIPMENT:

- A. Barbells: ZKC barbells will be used in competition and training.
- B. Results System: Competition management system approved by IWF.

#### 13. INSURANCE:

All participating federations/associations must undertake full moral and financial responsibility of their registered/accredited delegates with regard to their health and wellness and in case of accidents or damages not attributable to the OC.

#### 14. VISA INFORMATION:

At the moment all traveler's to Kenya must obtain visa before boarding the plane. All participants should contact the respective embassy in their own country for Entry Visas to Kenya.

#### Please Note:

The following conditions are required to board and enter Kenya.

- A. Visa before arrival- see attachment on how to apply
- B. Guide for Inbound Travellers to Kenya. (see attached guide)
- C. COVID-19 Trusted Travel Digital System and Jitenge Platform (see attached guide)

#### 15. FLAG AND ANTHEM:

Each participating team is kindly requested to bring along a CD/USB drive of their national anthem and two national flags  $1.0 \times 1.5 \text{ m}$ . These must be submitted upon arrival/accreditation.

#### 16. TRANSPORTATION:

- A. Local transportation will be provided from/to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for all delegations upon their arrival and departure.
- B. Accommodation and Transportation forms shale be sent with the final entries no later than 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 and shall state which airline and flight number of each delegate will be arriving on, and will be returned.
- **c.** The OC will provide local transportation between competition/training venues and hotel.

## 17. COVID-19 AND YELLOW FEVER CERTIFICATES:

Any participant person should provide maximum 72 hours negative PCR certificate and valid yellow fever certificate and these required certificates must be produced at the Airport.

A PCR test will be required and done for every one before competition at the hotel and before departure with a fee of US \$ 160 per person (two tests), and it's the responsibility of each national federation/association to cover the tests cost of its delegation.
