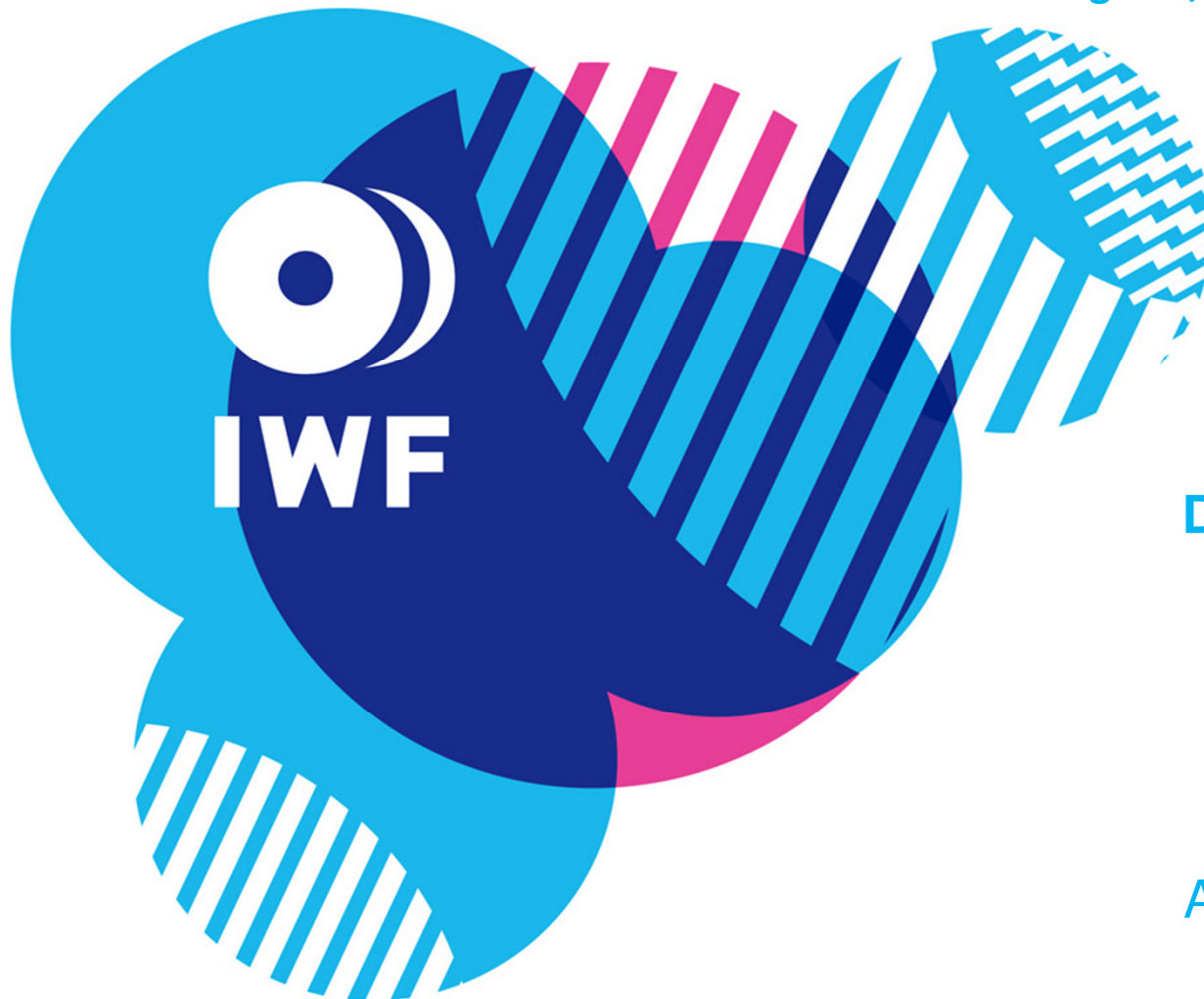

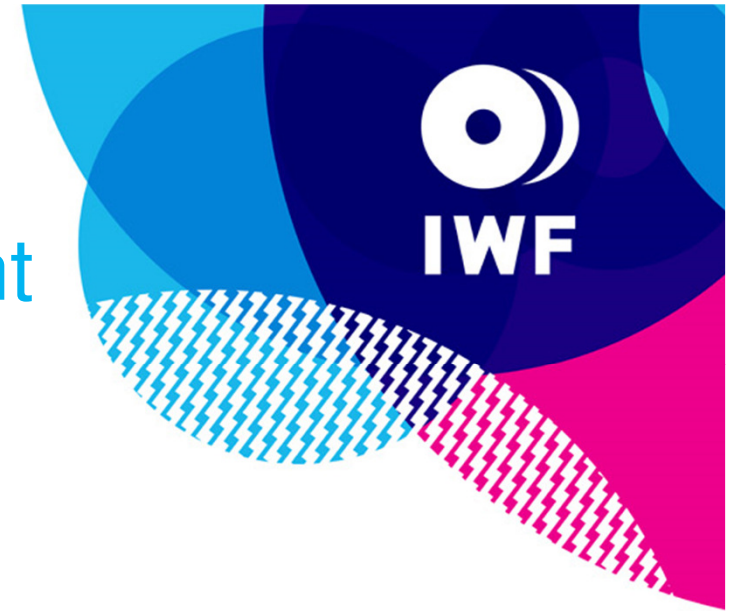

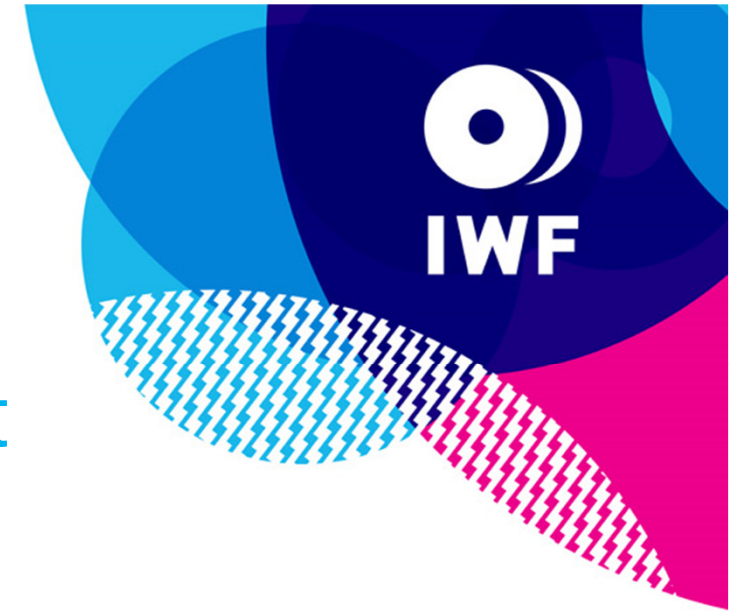

SAMPLE COLLECTION

- Developments since Tashkent

- **Increased OOC sample collection**
 - Focusing on high-risk countries
 - Adapted to Competition Calendar
- **Targeting aspects include**
 - Performance monitoring
 - ADRV history
 - Recommendations of the Athlete Passport Management Unit (the Cologne Laboratory) based on Steroidal Passports
 - Competition level and Testing Pool (eg. IRTP)
 - Other intelligence from such as
 - Testing mission reports
 - Whereabouts failures
 - Report doping platform





SAMPLE COLLECTION

- Developments since Tashkent

- OOC Testing Program planned and managed by the **Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport**
 - Test Distribution Plan approved and under execution
 - Involvement of a broader network of Service Providers/ National and Regional Anti-Doping Organisations
 - Helps to increase cost efficiency
 - Weightlifting-related expertise shared with more organisations
- Discussions of the IWF management with the **International Testing Agency**
 - Principles approved by the Executive Board
 - In the course of preparing the professional background of the cooperation
- The ADC is dedicated to carrying on with the current approach

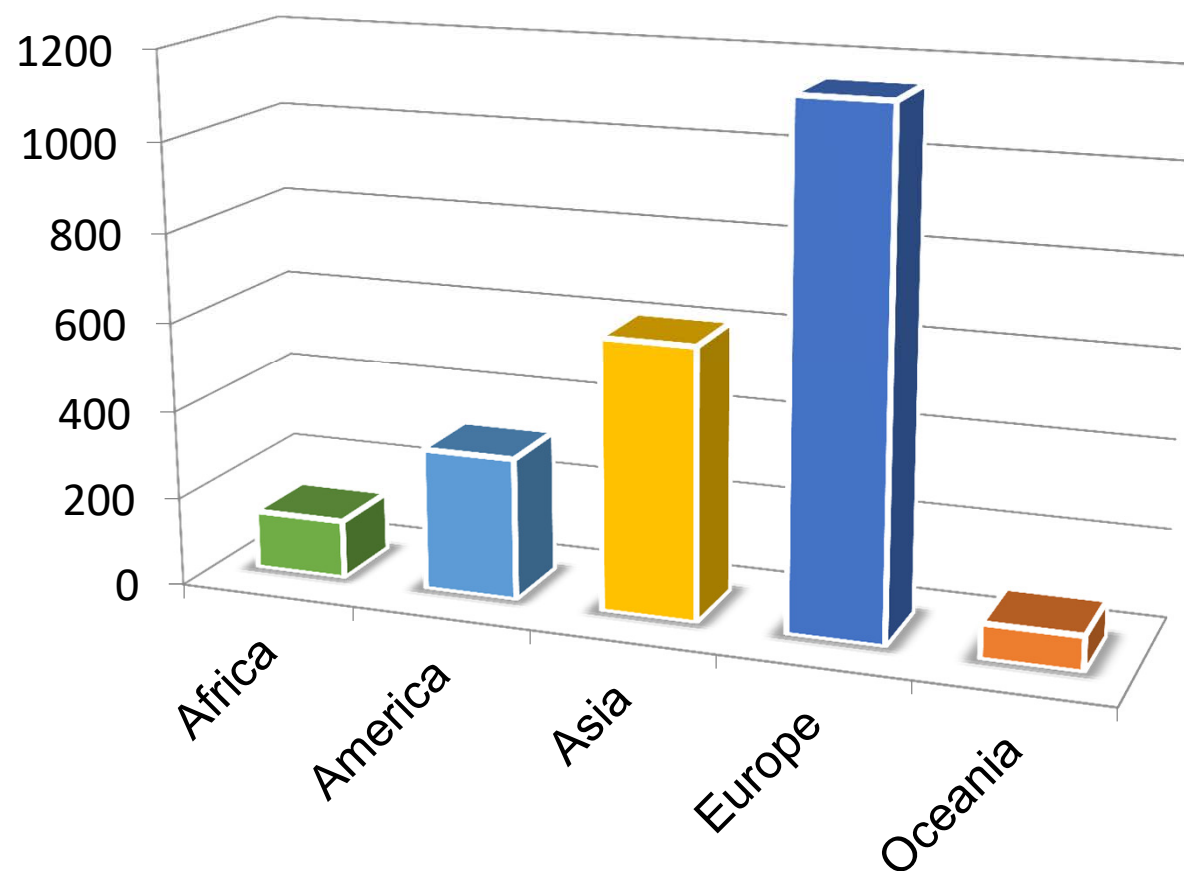

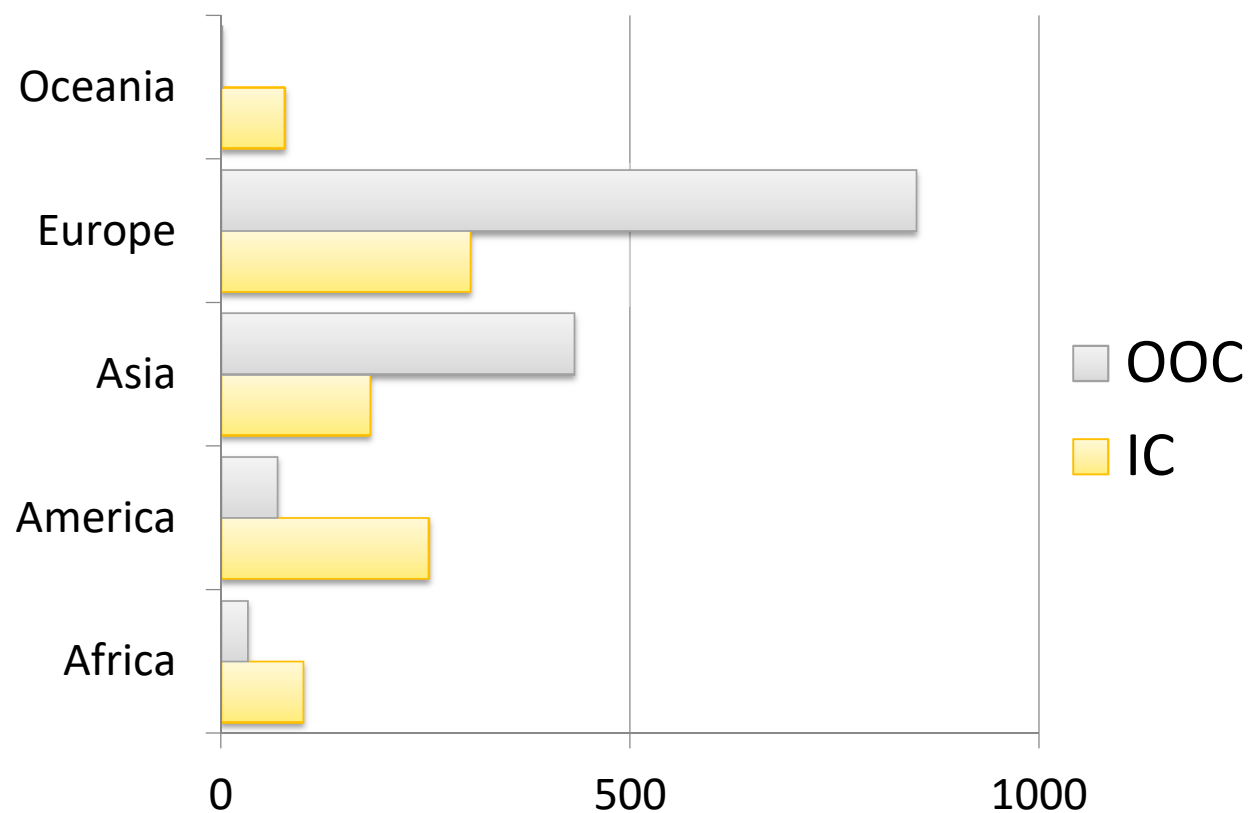

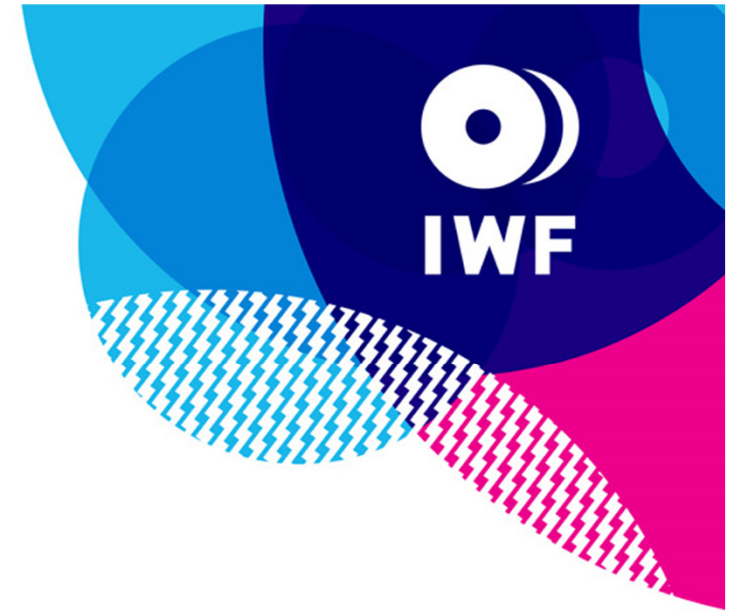
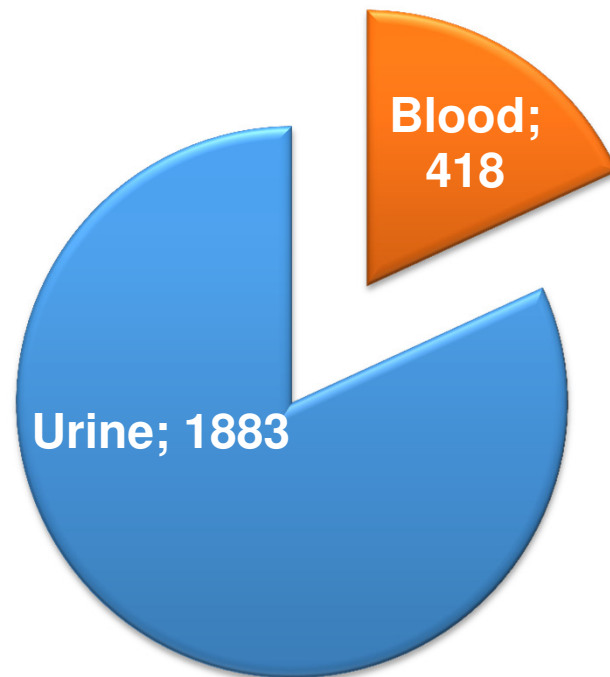
- IC / OOC by Continents

- Developments since Tashkent



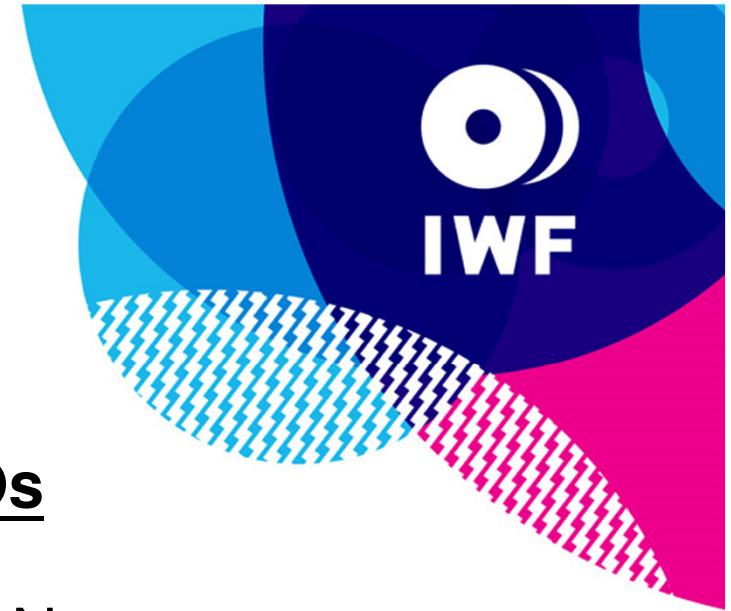
➤ **AD E-Learning Platform – iLiftCLEAN;**

- The Platform was brought to the Member Federations in cooperation USAWL and the USADA;
- 3 videos: Whereabouts, Doping Control Procedures, Rules of TUE;
- Languages: English, Spanish, Russian, Arabic;
- Videos -> Anti-Doping Test (9 questions);
- Final score at least 80% shall be obtained by the Athletes;
- Certificate will be valid for one year from the day of completion.
- Possible to complete at the Outreach and at the Training Venue.

All Athletes who participate at the Event shall complete the test.

Please note Article 5.6.5 of the IWF Anti-Doping Policy:

„An Athlete who is not listed on the IWF's Registered Testing Pool but wishes to participate in an IWF Event shall provide accurate and complete whereabouts information as set out at Annex I of the International Standard for Testing and Investigations for a period of at least two months prior to the IWF Event in question.

If the IWF Event is a World Championship (Youth, Junior and/or Senior), then the period shall be of at least three months prior to the event in question. An Athlete who does not comply with this provision is not eligible to compete at the IWF Event"

E-entry System Reminder



IWF Anti-Doping Policy

Please note Article 5.6.5 of the IWF Anti-Doping Policy which will be applicable for this Event:

„An Athlete who is not listed on the IWF's Registered Testing Pool but wishes to participate in an IWF Event shall provide accurate and complete whereabouts information as set out at Annex I of the International Standard for Testing and Investigations for a period of at least two months prior to the IWF Event in question.

If the IWF Event is a World Championship (Youth, Junior and/or Senior), then the period shall be of at least three months prior to the event in question. An Athlete who does not comply with this provision is not eligible to compete at the IWF Event"

Therefore please make sure that the **whereabouts** information of your Athletes wishing to compete at IWF World Championships is properly submitted until the **1ST AUGUST 2018** and throughout the whole competition.

Please note that this applies to Reserve Athletes as well, therefore **whereabouts information** of Reserve Athletes shall be provided in ADAMS too.

It is extremely crucial for them to be compliant with this rule, for otherwise they will not be able to compete.

WHEREABOUTS SUBMISSION - Exemptions



In accordance with Article 5.6.5 of the IWF ADP an exemption may be granted to the obligation to provide whereabouts where the strict application of that rule would be manifestly unfair to the Athlete.

An exemption may not be granted for the following examples:

- The fact that travel arrangements of the athlete for the respective competition had been already made;
- Negligent behaviour of either the Athlete or the Federation;
- Miscommunication between the Federation and the Athlete;
- Technical difficulties due to Internet connection, Access to ADAMS, E-mail account related problems.

WHEREABOUTS SUBMISSION – How can you help the Athlete?



Spreadsheet which includes the following information properly:

- ✓ Athlete name;
- ✓ 1 hour time slot (location and time);
- ✓ Overnight accommodation (location and time);
- ✓ The Athlete phone number;
- ✓ The Athletes e-mail address;

**ALWAYS IN THE RESPECTIVE DEADLINE
BEFORE THE EVENT.**

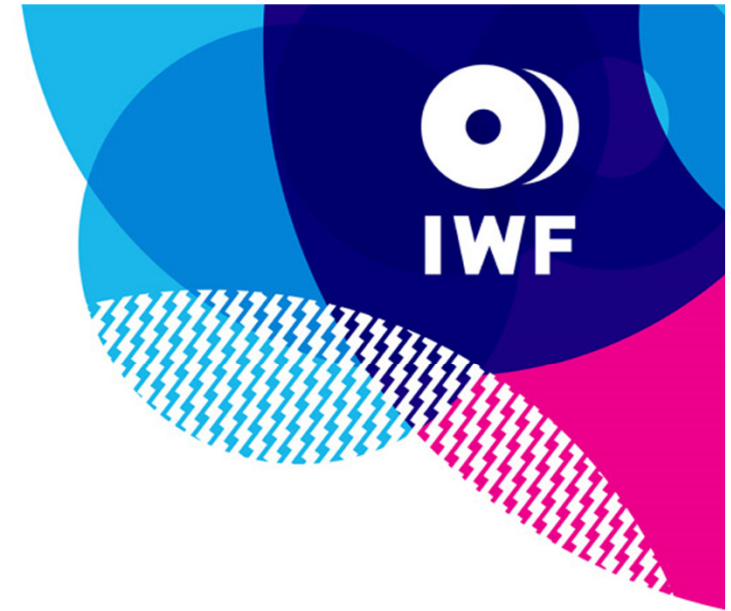

- ADAMS System → World Anti-Doping Agency
- Security → constantly changes
 - TOTP code
- GDPR → Passwords **ONLY** via Whatsapp/Viber
- Providing us with the MF's official email address and mobile number

ATHLETE SUPPORT PERSONNEL

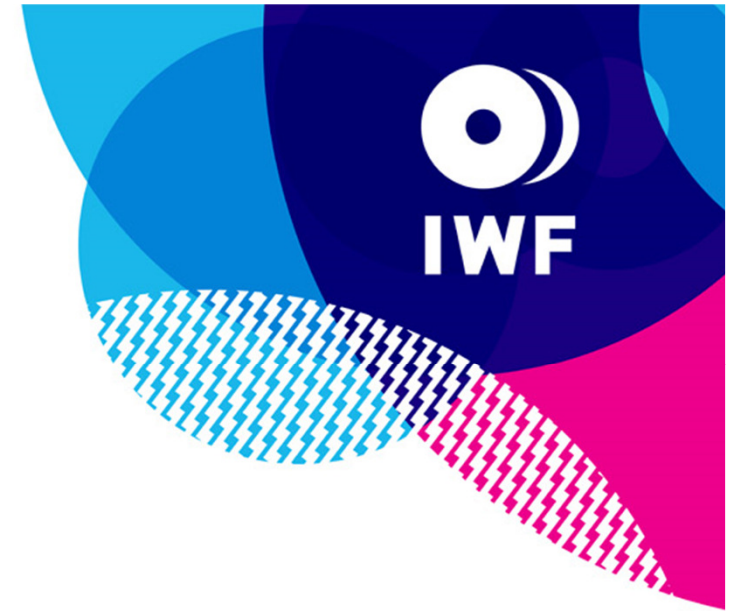
- MFs' obligation to submit
information to the IWF



- New rule in the IWF ADP – effective with 15 April 2018
- Information about Athlete Support Personnel affiliated to National Team Athletes and Athletes included in the International Registered Testing Pool shall be shared with the IWF
- Database useful for both the MFs and the IWF
- Informs investigations related to Anti-Doping Rule Violations

ATHLETE SUPPORT PERSONNEL

- In Practice



Providing IWF with the following information:

- List of Athlete Support Personnel affiliated with MF's National Teams (coaches, doctors, etc.)
- Signed form by coaches and doctors

Standard Form for Athlete Support Personnel
as per Article 16.3 of the IWF Anti-Doping Policy

I, [Name of Athlete Support Person], born on [Date of Birth], affiliated to the [Name of the MF], hereby expressly undertake to at all times comply with and to be bound by the provisions of the IWF Anti-Doping Policy.

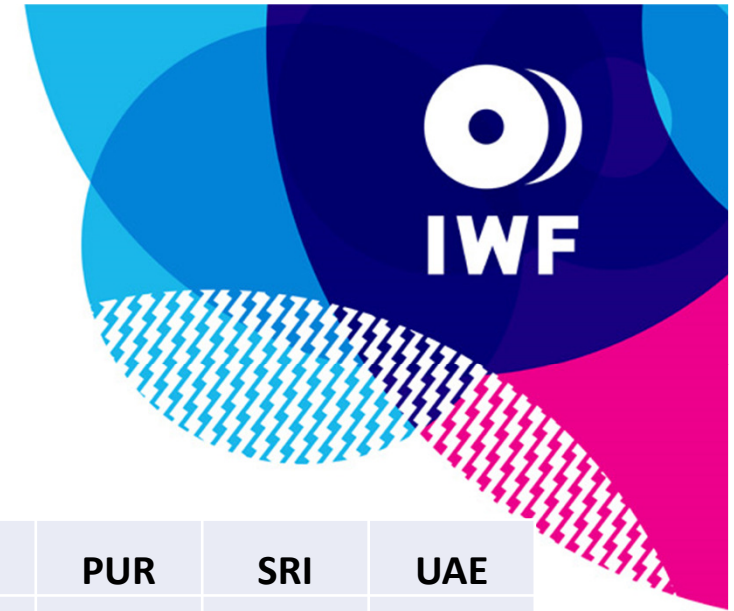

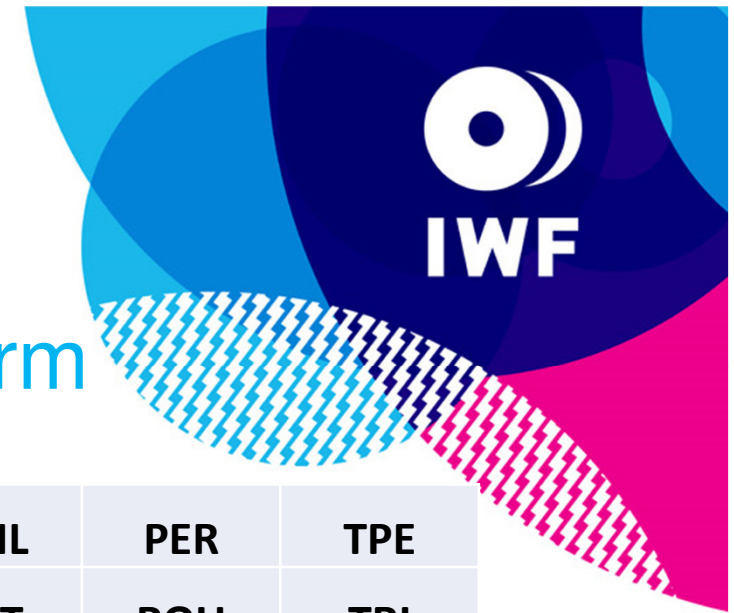

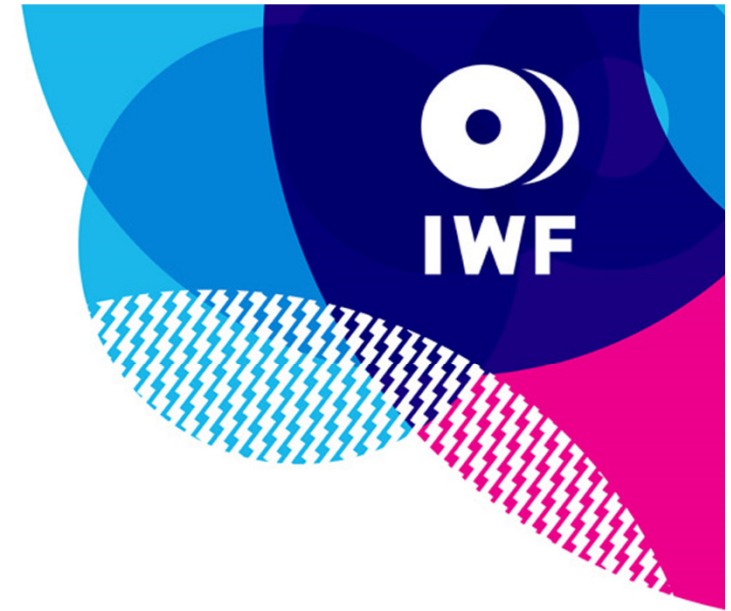

Investigations - 2018



- **Manipulation cases result from APMU investigations**
- **Ongoing investigations are based on:**
 - Intelligence through
 - Whereabouts failures
 - Information about Athlete Support Personnel
 - Whistleblower platform - info
 - Member Federations
 - Officials
 - Athletes
 - Information received from WADA
- **Investigations are coordinated and/or directed by WADA**
