### What is Competition Manipulation?





## What is competition manipulation?



When athletes cheat by losing on purpose or by not doing their best in a competition

When officials or coaches deliberately make wrong decisions, affecting the competition or its outcome

This is competition manipulation!

### Two main reasons why this happens







### To gain a sporting advantage

When the athlete **underperforms** in order **to face an easier opponent** in the next round of the competition.



### To make money

When the competition is manipulated in order to increase the odds of a bet and make more money.

### Risks & Possible Sanctions

### **Possible Sanctions**



Sports sanction	<b>Criminal sanction</b>
Ban (up to life) and fine	Jail and fine
You may get a life ban from your sport for manipulating a competition.	Competition manipulation is considered a criminal offence in a growing number of countries.

### Loss of credibility

Loss of sponsors and fans. Ruining of your personal credibility and reputation worldwide.

### Code of Conduct: The 4 Key Rules

## **CODE OF CONDUCT**





**DON'T FIX** your competition and always do your best.

**DON'T BET** on your own sport or the Olympic Games.

**DON'T SHARE** inside information. Non-public information about your sport stays private.

# **RULE #2**

DON'T BET

If you are an IWF official from Asia, can you bet on weightlifting competitions in Europe?

**No.** Athletes & officials must not bet on their own sport, even if it is in a different region.

If you are judging an IWF competition at the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games, can you bet on the Tokyo 2020 Volleyball events?

**No.** Accredited athletes and officials must not bet on any event of the Olympic Games.

If you are officiating a weightlifting competition at the Commonwealth Games, can you bet on the Football events at the Commonwealth Games?

**No.** Athletes must not bet on any sport in a multi-sport competition that they themselves are competing in.
