## 1. Elections

Electoral Manager made an introduction explaining the electoral process.
The number of Full Members attending in the room was 120. 27 Full Members were registered online. -- The maximum potential number of votes was 149, including the two voting athletes representatives.
The total number of Full Members of IWF is 162. The quorum being $50 \%$ plus 1 more of the Full Members according to the IWF Constitution, the quorum is 82 and it was met (both on 25-26 and on 30 June for the on-line voting, see point 1.2 below).

As a preliminary issue before the actual elections, the Congress decided on Rule 22.2 of the IWF Constitution, i.e. vote on up to three candidates being allowed to hold a seat on the IWF Executive Board after the age of 70 years of age.

To the questions where the Congress approves each candidate as candidate for executive board election over 70 years of age, the Congress decided by Ordinary Resolution of Simple Majority that the three candidates concerned by this rule, Constantino Iglesias RODRIGUEZ (ESP), Salvatore COFFA (AUS) and Mohammed Awadh Al-Jarmal ABDULLAH (YEM), were eligible to stand for IWF Elections:

Constantino Iglesias RODRIGUEZ (ESP): 60 votes YES, 49 votes NO, 7 Abstentions Salvatore COFFA (AUS): 69 votes YES, 42 votes NO, 9 Abstentions Mohammed Awadh Al-Jarmal ABDULLAH (YEM), 76. votes YES, 48 votes NO, 6 Abstentions

### 1.1 Election of President

The Election Manager asked each of the candidates if they confirmed their candidature. Only Mr. Al-Mana and Mr Mohammad Jalood confirmed their candidatures. Each country was called to vote. The votes were cast and the voting process completed. At this point, prior to the counting of the votes, a discussion arose regarding potential withdrawal of the candidates. Finally, Mr AI-Mana declared to the Congress that he had decided to withdraw in the interest of sport and in favor of Mr Jalood. The Congress spontaneously acclaimed Mr Jalood as the elected president.
The Election Manager announced Mr Jalood as the chosen IWF President and Mr Jalood was again acclaimed by the Congress. No objection was raised by any delegate.

The actual count of the votes expressed in the voting process which had been completed prior to Mr AI Mana's withdrawal occurred at a later stage ${ }^{1}$. This count confirmed the following results of the conducted vote:

Eligible votes: 148.
Applicable Simple Majority : 75
96 votes for Mr Jalood

### 1.2 Election of General Secretary Treasurer

There were 17 original candidates. After the Election Manager have asked each of the candidates if they confirm their candidatures, only three people maintained their candidatures.

Simple Majority threshold applicable to this round: 75

Due to an error in the calculation of the Simple Majority threshold at the time of the election Mr Quinones was mistakenly announced as elected. Since Mr Quinones had not obtained the Simple Majority actually a second round between the two candidates having obtained the more votes was still required ${ }^{2}$.

After the issue had appeared a second voting round was decided by the Electoral Commission and organised and held on line on 30 June 2022:

[^0]:    1 The counting of the votes did not occur at the meeting but later. Indeed, as explained in the Statement of the IWF Electoral Commission Chair and IWF Election Manager dated 29 June 2022 (See Annex 1), after the public withdrawal of Mr. Al-Mana confirmed in writing, Mr. Jalood - as sole remaining candidate - had been acclaimed by the Congress and in the circumstances it was held that he could be deemed as elected president. Later, on 29 June 2022, the votes were actually counted by the Electoral Commission and the Electoral Manager. This count confirmed that in the voting process completed prior to the withdrawal of Mr. AlMana, Mr Jalood had reached the required Simple Majority of the votes (i.e. 75) receiving 96 votes.

[^1]:    2 Mr. Quinones himself raised the issue with the Electoral Commission on 27 June 2022. Thereupon the Electoral Commission realized the error made and decided to organize a second voting round to complete the election in accordance with the Constitution. This voting round was organized online by LUMI on 30 June 2022 as mentioned in the Statement from the IWF Electoral Commission sent on 27 June 2022 (See Annex 2). No objection was raised before the vote. Mr. Urso was elected at this second round (See Statement from the IWF Electoral Commission Chair and IWF Election Manager dated 30 June 2022, Annex 3).
