







RESULTS ACHIEVED IN NON-OLYMPIC BODYWEIGHT CATEGORIES - MEN

Total results achieved by athletes in non-Olympic bodyweight categories (M55kg, M67kg, M81kg, M96kg & M109kg) will be included in the Olympic Qualification Ranking (OQR) in the respective Olympic bodyweight category that incorporates their weight as indicated in the table.

EXAMPLE:

The athlete's Total result achieved in the M109kg bodyweight category at the 2022 IWF World Championships, will be included in the Olympic bodyweight category of M+102kg.

The highest Total Result achieved by each athlete at qualification events will be counted towards their overall ranking, taking into consideration that only one (1) athlete per Olympic bodyweight category per NOC (with the highest Total result in kilograms) will be included in the OQR.

Total results achieved by athletes in non-Olympic bodyweight categories (W45kg, W55kg, W64kg, W76kg & W87kg) will be included in the Olympic Qualification Ranking (OQR) in the respective Olympic bodyweight category that incorporates their weight as indicated in the table.

EXAMPLE:

The athlete's Total result achieved in the W55kg bodyweight category at the 2023 IWF World Championships, will be included in the Olympic bodyweight category of W59kg.

The highest Total Result achieved by each athlete at qualification events will be counted towards their overall ranking, taking into consideration that only one (1) athlete per Olympic bodyweight category per NOC (with the highest Total result in kilograms) will be included in the OQR.

NOC QUOTA PLACES

| Gender | Quota Places by NOC |

EVENT FIELD SIZE

| Gender | Maximum No. per Event |

TYPE OF QUOTA PLACES

Quota places are allocated to the athlete(s) by name

If an NOC has more than three (3) athletes in one gender who are eligible to receive quota places, then the NOC / MF will decide which of these athletes will receive the quota places, respecting the maximum number of athletes per NOC per event

Host country quota places are allocated to the NOC for eligible athletes

Universality quota places are allocated to the eligible athlete by name

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

IOC Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (WADA code)

Age Requirements: Athletes must be born on or before 31 December 2009

QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

| Quota Places | Olympic Qualification Ranking |
|--|--|
| 50 Men 50 Women (Total 100 athletes) | The IWF will be publishing the OQR including one athlete per Olympic bodyweight categories per NOC with the highest Totals (in kilograms). |
| | one (1) athlete per NOC shall be ranked on the OQR |
| | If two, or more, athletes record the same total in the same Olympic bodyweight category they shall be ranked in order of which achieved the result first, using equivalent Greenwich Mean Times (GMT) to decide such if necessary. |

QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

| Quota Places | Olympic Qualification Ranking |
|--|--|
| 50 Men 50 Women (Total 100 athletes) | If an athlete is ranked in the top 10 in more than one event in the OQR, then the NOC / MF will decide. |
| | Athlete will then be removed from the OQR in other bodyweight categories. Any freed ranking position due to declaration of competing in another event will then automatically move to the next highest ranked eligible athlete |
| | 6 May 2024 |

QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

| Quota Places | Olympic Qualification Ranking |
|--|---|
| 50 Men 50 Women (Total 100 athletes) | Should an NOC record more than three (3) athletes per gender from different weight categories in the OQR then the relevant NOC / MF must declare to the IWF by 15 May 2024. |
| | Any athletes not so declared will then be removed from the OQR. Any declined ranking positions and quota places will then automatically move to the next highest ranked eligible athlete from an NOC which has not used its three quota places. |
| | End of Qualification: 28 April 2024 |

CONTINENTAL REPRESENTATION

| Quota Places | Olympic Qualification Ranking |
|---|---|
| 5 Men 5 Women (Total 10 athletes) | To achieve the widest possible representation across the IWF recognised Continental Federations <u>one quota place will be distributed to each Olympic bodyweight category</u> using the OQR and the following criteria: |
| One Athlete Per Bodyweight Category | The highest ranked eligible athlete of a category representing an NOC that its Continent is not already represented in the Top 10 of her/his bodyweight category, will be allocated a quota place. |
