

*Special Anti-doping rules for the Youth Olympic Games – Nanjing 2014*

*All athletes entered in or participating in Olympic Qualification Events must undergo anti-doping controls in accordance with the IWF Anti-Doping Policy (ADP).*

1. In accordance with the IWF Anti Doping Policy (“ADP”) (12.3.1.G) if *nine or more violations* of these Anti-Doping Rules (other than under articles 2.4 or 10.3) are committed by Athletes or other Persons affiliated with a Member Federation (“MF”) within a Calendar year period in testing conducted by the IWF or Anti-Doping Organizations other than the National or its National Anti-Doping Organization, then the IWF Executive Board may suspend that MF’s membership for a period of up to 4 years. In addition, such MF/National Olympic Committee (“NOC”) shall not be permitted to enter competitors for the next ensuing Youth Olympic /Olympic Games. If such MF is permitted to compete in any Olympic Qualifying event prior to the next ensuing Youth Olympic /Olympic Games, the MF shall not secure any Olympic qualifying points in such event.
2. In case *four or five* violations of these Anti-Doping Rules (other than under ADP articles 2.4 or 10.3) are committed by Athletes or other Persons affiliated with a Member Federation (“MF”) during the Youth Olympic Games qualification period, on In- and Out-of-Competition Control, with regard to youth age group athletes - in case the IWF Executive Board does not suspend the MF concerned according to Point 1. - the IWF may withdraw *one quota* from that MF/NOC with regard to the ensuing Youth Olympic Games.
3. In case *six or more* violations of these Anti-Doping Rules, (other than under Articles 2.4 or 10.3) are committed by Athletes or other Persons affiliated with a Member Federation (“MF”) during the Youth Olympic Games qualification period, on In- and Out-of-Competition Control, with regard to youth age group athletes - in case the IWF Executive Board does not suspend the MF concerned according to Point 1. - the IWF may withdraw *two quota* from that MF/NOC with regard to the ensuing Youth Olympic Games.
4. The quotas withdrawn in accordance with Section 1. 2. and 3. above shall be reallocated by the IWF in accordance with the Qualification Regulation Reallocation Policy.
