The competition will be held in accordance with the rules of the International Weightlifting Federation (IWF) based on FISU regulations, and with close supervision from the Thai Amateur Weightlifting Association (TWA) of Thailand.

Chiang Mai City, the host of WUC 2014, a well-known tourist destination; is a paradise for tourists from around the world. Additionally, it has experience in hosting international sports competitions such as 15th ASEAN University Games (Karate-do) at North Chiang Mai University, The Royal World Weightlifting Championship (RWWC) in 2007 and the 1st Youth World Weightlifting Championship (YWWWC). 2. TRANSPORTATION

Entry into Thailand. Most flights from Europe, North and South America, and elsewhere will transit via Suvarnabhumi International Airport in Bangkok. There are only a few airlines from Asia that have direct flights to Chiang Mai International Airport. Please check with the airline agents before booking tickets. We recommend all athletes buy tickets that check through to Chiang Mai International Airport. Passengers will transit at Suvarnabhumi International Airport and transfer to Chiang Mai by a domestic airline. Therefore, your suitcases and belongings may not be collected at Chiang Mai International airport in the International Terminal. It must be the responsibility of individual participants to check before boarding whether their baggage will be transported direct to Chiang Mai International Airport.

The Organizing Committee (OC) will provide transportation to and from the designated hotel only for athletes who arrive at Chiang Mai International Airport. The OC will not be responsible for providing any means of transportation either by bus or train or from other airports which is not arranged by the OC in advance.

3. ACCOMMODATION

All WUC participants and officials will be accommodated in Pang Suan Kaew Hotel in Chiang Mai, in the city but not close to the weightlifting venue. The bookings of accommodation will be taken care of by the Organizing Committee. Most rooms for the participants are twin and triple. Breakfast and supper will be served in the hotel. Lunch will be served both at the hotel and the Venue (times will be given in the competition schedule). All Teams will receive food coupons during accreditation. Bus schedules, results and other information for participants will be published daily in the hotel lobby.

The period of WUC accommodation is 2^{nd} to 9^{th} December 2014. Participants and officials arriving before December 2rd and departing after December 8th will pay a fee 120 EUR per person per day for these extra days.

4. NON-PARTICIPANTS AND NON-FISU FAMILY MEMBERS

Non participants and non FISU family members will not be accommodated by the Organizing Committee (OC) but if they would like the the OC to facilitate accommodation and transportation, they have to contact the OC in advance. The cost incurred will be their responsibility. This will include transportation from hotel to the Venue. Food will not be provided but there will be food sold at the Venue to facilitate the spectators.

5. CITY TOUR

City tour is organized by the OC upon the request of each team or individual. The city tour information is to be inquired at the hotel. The travel and the fee will be paid by team or individual. The OC is only to facilitate with tourism agents.

6. PARTICIPATION

Only competitors who meet the following conditions may take part in the event:

- a) Be a national of the country they represent
- b) Be at least 17 and less than 28 years of age.
- c) Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country
- d) Former students of the institutions who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event

7. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will be done via the FISU Accreditation System and final scores will be checked at the Lotus Pang Suan Kaew Hotel, Chiang Mai.

7. ENTRIES

All entry forms must be submitted via FISU Accreditation System - http://wuc.in-1.it/

The General Entry form (G1/G2) must be submitted no later than 5 June 2014

Quantitative entry form (Q1) indicating the number of officials and participants by **5 September 2014**

Nominative/ Individual entry with the list of officials, competitors and the substitute, the events in which they participate and the necessary photographs must be sent by **5 November 2014.**, together with travel information.

8. Participation fee

FISU Registration Fees

FISU shall receive from each competing country the following FISU registration fees:

- Effective member associations of FISU: 20 EUR per competitor and official

Participation Fees to the Organizing Committee (full board and event services): - a participation fee of 60 EUR per person per day established by FISU (2 December -9 December 2014)

Entry before 2^{nd} December and checkout after 9^{th} December 2014; a participant must pay an extra fee of 120 per person per day.

Preferable way of lodging money is bank transfer. All details regarding OC account will be informed soon.

The competing countries, upon arrival, shall pay their dues for participation fees 60 Euro determined by the Executive Committee per day and per person to the Organizing Committee. However, we encourage Teams to pay total amount via bank transfer.
