



Women's 69kg - Review

Ryo Un Hui (PRK) second athlete from DPR Korea to record hat-trick

- Ryo Un Hui (PRK) won all three events in the women's 69kg on Friday and became the second athlete from DPR Korea to win all three gold medals in a single event after Kim Un Guk (PRK) achieved this feat in the men's 62kg earlier at the 2014 World Championships.
- Ryo Un Hui became the first woman from DPR Korea to win a gold medal at the World Championships above the 58kg category.
- She claimed two silver and one bronze medal in this event in last year's World Championships.
- Her six total world championships medals ranks her second among DPR Korean women, surpassing Li Yong Hwa (PRK, 5 medals). Only Ri Song Hui (DPR) has won more (11).
- In each of the last five World Championships, one woman took all three gold medals (Snatch, Clean and Jerk and Total) in this event.
- It was the ninth time a woman won all three gold medals in this event, only the women's 48kg had more hat-trick (11), since the introduction of the current weight categories in 1998.
- Zhazira Zhapparkul (KAZ) gave Kazakhstan their first medals in the women's 69kg event after she claimed bronze in the Snatch and silver in the Clean and Jerk and Total.
