## 5. Entries

### 5.1 Eligibility

5.1.1 To be eligible for participation in the 33<sup>rd</sup> SEA Games, a competitor must comply with the latest Technical and Competition Rules of & Regulations (TCRR) of the International Weightlifting Federation (IWF) and the SEA Games Federation (SEAGF). Charter and Rules as well as Rule 40 and the By-law to Rule 40 of the Olympic Charter (Participation in the Games).

5.1.2 Only nationals of the country of the NOC shall be qualified to represent the NOC in the Games. All disputes relating to the determination of the country, which an athlete may represent in the 33<sup>rd</sup> SEA Games shall be resolved in accordance with SEAGF Charter and Rules as well as Rule 41 and By-law to Rule 41 of the Olympic Charter (Nationality of competitors).

5.1.3 Participating Athletes must be 15 years of age and over (year of birth 2010 or earlier).

5.1.4 Not currently under disqualification or suspension by their NOC, IWF or under the World Anti-Doping Code.

5.1.5 In accordance with article 5.5.16 of the IWF Anti-Doping Rules 2024, whereabouts information of the athletes shall be submitted at a minimum of three (03) months prior to the Games. Any athlete who does not comply with this provision is not eligible to participate. Athletes who wish to compete at the 33<sup>rd</sup> SEA Games shall submit their whereabouts information for the period outlined above at the latest on the **13<sup>th</sup> September 2025**

### 5.2 Submission of Entries

Registration of each National Olympic Committee (NOC) must comply with the regulations of National Olympic Committees of Thailand Organizing Committee (NOCTOC).

#### 5.2.1 Entry by Number

- Deadline for submission of Entry by Number Forms is on **8<sup>th</sup> April 2025** at 24.00 hours. Thailand time (GMT+7).

#### 5.2.2 Entry by Name

- Deadline for submission of Entry by Name Forms (online) is on **26<sup>th</sup> September 2025** at 24.00 hours. Thailand Time (GMT+7).

The completed Entry by Name must be submitted for each athlete and include all necessary information . Original form must be presented during the Delegation Registration Meeting (DRM).

#### **Technical Officials**

The appointments of Technical Officials will be in accordance with IWF TCRR and the SEAGF Charter and Rules.

- International Technical Officials (ITOs)  
SEAWF as duly authorized by IWF, shall appoint Technical Delegate and the International Technical Officials (ITOs) .The names shall be listed by SEAWF approved by NOCTOC. NOCTOC will cover domestic and international transportations, accommodations and Per diem for the Technical Delegate (TD) and ITOs.
- National Technical Official (NTOs)  
Thai Amateur Weightlifting Association ( TAWA) will appoint such number of National Technical Officials (NTOs) as may be approved by NOCTOC.

## 7. Competition Procedures, Rules and Regulations

The Weightlifting competition will be conducted in accordance to the IWF TCRR in force. In case of translation related disagreement over the interpretation of the rules and regulations the English version shall prevail. Any unforeseen case not addressed by the rules and regulations shall be dealt with as follows:

General issues: To be resolved in accordance with the SEAGF Charter and Rules

Technical issues: to be resolved in accordance with IWF TCRR and/or IWF Constitution.

### 7.1 Competitional Format

- Each NOC may enter a maximum of one (1) athlete per event.
- One medal is to be given for the Total result only. (No medal for the Snatch and the Clean and Jerk). If an athlete does not achieve a valid lift in the Snatch, they will be eliminated from the competition and cannot participate in the Clean & Jerk.
- Competition will be held in accordance with the latest IWF TCRR, of which the Snatch and the Clean and Jerk are included. The results will be ranked according to the aggregated Total weight achieved if the two types of lifts (the Snatch and the Clean and Jerk) are valid. Gold, silver and bronze medals are awarded respectively to the first three (3) places for the Total in each of events.

#### **Delays, postponement or cancellations**

The Technical Delegate must consult the NOCTOC Secretariat if there is any delay, postponement or cancellation of any competition that affects the scheduled times for “live broadcast” or victory ceremonies.

### 7.2 SEAGF Article 30 – General Rules of the SEA Games

To be eligible for participation in the SEA Games, a competitor must comply with the SEA Games Federation Charter and Rules as well as Rule 40 and the By-law to Rule 40 of the Olympic Charter (Participation in the Games).

### 7.3 SEAGF Article 31 – Nationality of Competitor

Only nationals of the country of the NOC shall be qualified to represent the NOC in the Games. All disputes relating to determination of the country. Which a competitor may represent in accordance with the By-law to Rule 41 of the Olympic Charter (Nationality of Competitors).

#### 7.4 Equipment and Clothing

Equipment used and clothing worn by athletes and other relevant participants in competition must comply with the rules and regulations of the SEAGF Charter and IWF TCRR in force.

IWF approved Sport Equipment will be used in the Competition, Training and Warm -Up.

Neither athletes nor technical officials can attach any form of commercial advertising to his or her competition uniform or technical official uniform without prior agreement with SEAGF Charter and NOCTOC.

#### 7.5 Doping Control

7.5.1 NOCTOC under the guidance of the SEAGF Charter, will be responsible for the Anti-Doping Programme during the 33<sup>rd</sup> SEA Games. The Anti-Doping Programme will be implemented in accordance with SEAGF Charter Anti-Doping Rules and the World Anti-Doping Code and its relevant International Standards.

7.5.2 NOCTOC are responsible for providing necessary conditions for Doping Control activities at the 33<sup>rd</sup> SEA Games. Doping Control procedures will be implemented according to WADA's International Standards for Testing and Investigations. Sample analysis will be performed at a WADA-accredited laboratory.

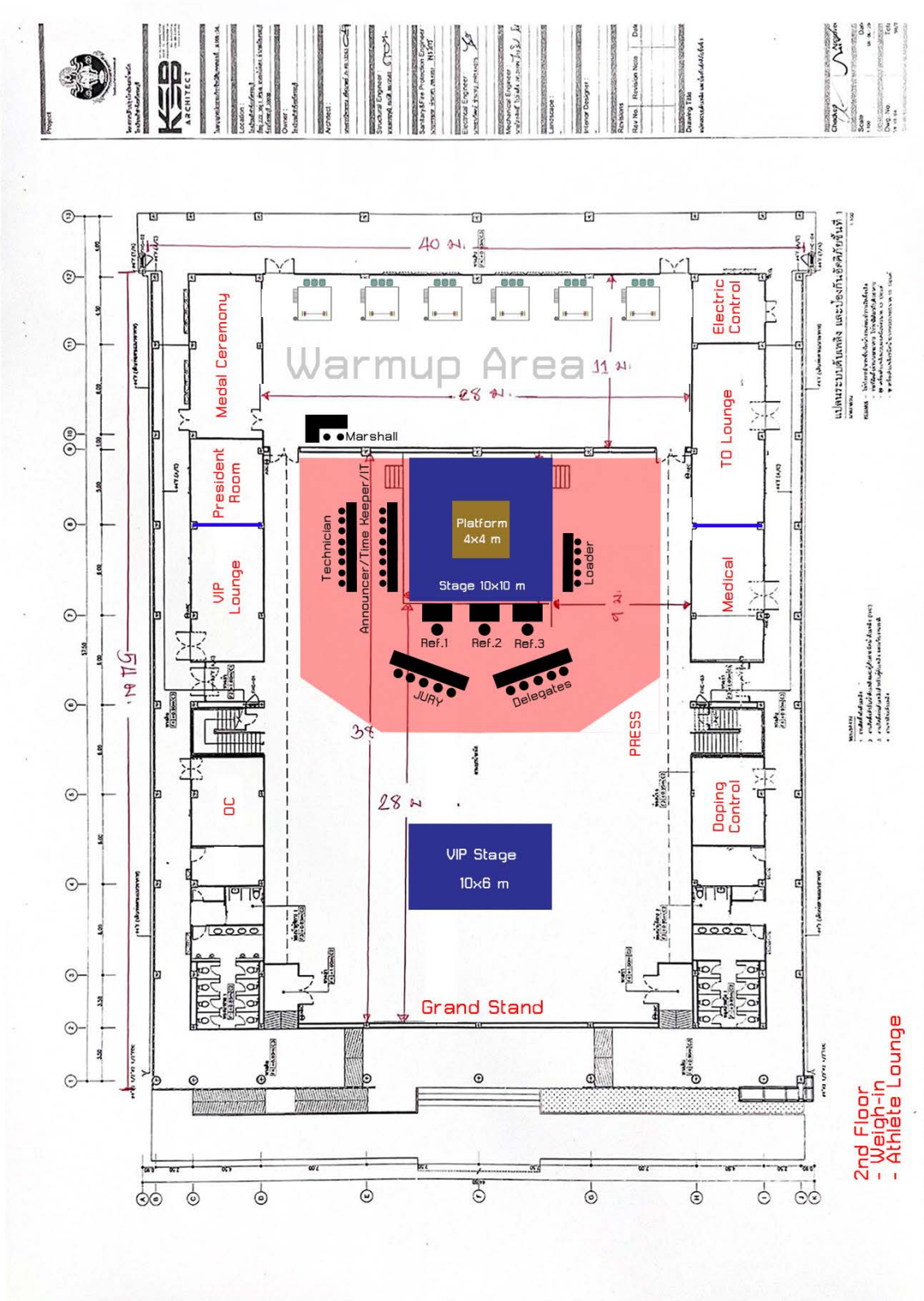
7.5.3 Doping Control Stations will be set up at the competition venue by NOCTOC, where in-competition testing will be conducted. The Test Distribution Plan and criteria for athlete selection for each sport will comply with the Doping Control protocol established by the NOCTOC and WADA

7.5.4 During the Games, all athletes are subject to doping control organized by NOCTOC. Testing or sampling can be done at any time and place without any notice.

7.5.5 WADA 2024 List of Prohibited Substances and Methods is applied in accordance with the WADA Code.

## 8.2 Records

In case a record/records is/are established in Men +98kg or Women +77kg categories which is/are equivalent to new record(s) in Men 110/+110 or Women 86/+86 categories, the IWF and Asian Weightlifting Federation (AWF) will not consider it/them as an official record(s), unless otherwise established by Youth athletes (born either on 2008 - 2010) as these bodyweight categories are not existing in Senior or Junior bodyweight categories under the IWF TCRR. Furthermore, the results established in these bodyweight categories by Senior or Junior athletes cannot be applied to the results for heavier bodyweight categories (i.e., Men 110/+110, Women 86/+86) according to IWF TCRR 8.9.

## 9. Approval of the Technical Handbook

This Technical Handbook was approved by the South East Asian Weightlifting Federation (SEAWF) as duly authorized by the International Weightlifting Federation (IWF), on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2025.
